FOREWORD

Rhyl & District Motor Club Limited has agreed to update and publish its annual Championship Rules to ensure openness and clarity to its Members and further encourage participation in sporting and social events under the name of Rhyl & District Motor Club.

Part of the emphasis within the changes of the Rules is to give more encouragement to those members willing to become involved in the organisation of Club Events.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

Rhyl & District Motor Club Limited will promote during 2017/2018 a number of Championships for its members. Details of the Championships are given in the following pages. The Championships will run from the 1st December to the 30th November.

These regulations cancel all previous Championship Regulations of Rhyl & District Motor Club and all Members will be assumed to be familiar with their content.

All the Championships are open to all fully paid-up members of Rhyl & District Motor Club Limited and points will not be awarded until subscriptions have been fully paid. Points will not be awarded retrospectively.

To be eligible for points the event entry fee must have been paid.

Members will be classed as either Expert or Novice when joining and thereafter upon renewal of membership by the Club Executive Committee.

• **Claiming Championship Points**

Points will be scored by participating in qualifying events in accordance with the points scoring systems within these regulations, providing the entry list demonstrates that you have entered the event under Rhyl & District Motor Club. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure this is done.

It is the member's responsibility to ensure that the necessary information (proof of entry and results) is received by the Competition Secretary within FOUR WEEKS of the event,

except for the end of the championship year when the time limit will be 23:59hrs on the last day of November.

Championship tables will be published on the Club website monthly and again it is the member's responsibility to check their correctness. You will have 21 days from the date of the published tables to appeal any points queries relating to events from the previous four weeks.

Any dispute regarding the Championships must be addressed to the Competition Secretary and if requested to be in writing. Any disputes will be resolved finally by a decision of Club's Executive Committee.

You will not be entitled to query points on events older than four weeks.

Provisional 'End of Year' Championship tables will be published soon after the end of November and they will be declared final after 21 days from date of publication

• Awards Presentation

All Championship awards will be presented at the Annual Awards Dinner to be held after the conclusion of the Championship year. All named awards remain the property of Rhyl & District Motor Club Limited and are to be returned after 11 months, or on demand of the Executive Committee.

It is a rule of the Club that all members eligible for a Championship award, must be in attendance at the Awards Dinner to be eligible to receive any perpetual award. If a genuine reason is given in writing to the Competition Secretary for not being able to attend, the Executive Committee will consider the application and if accepted the award will be given. In such cases, the award winner must nominate an attendee to sign for and collect the award on their behalf.

In awarding Championship trophies the Executive Committee will have regard to the number of participating competitors in the Championship and may choose to vary the awards allocation detailed in these Championship rules.

Any changes to these regulations will be agreed by the Club's Executive Committee and will be published within the Club

website, and they will have the same jurisdiction as these regulations.

THE CHAMPIONSHIP STRUCTURE

There are some basic changes to the Championship structure and they are:-

The points scheme for all but the Social Championship and Marshalling Championship is split into three points levels for competitive events, and they are:-

- Clubmans
- National B
- National A including International

Top Dog Clubmans Championship will attract points for events at Clubman level where Rhyl & District Motor Club has NOT been invited by the Organising Club.

The Top Dog Championship will attract points from National 'B', National 'A' and International events where Rhyl & District Motor Club has NOT been invited as a club.

Points will be awarded for organising as well as marshalling, within the Marshals Championship, except for organising social events which will attract points within the Social Championship.

The points system is illustrated in appendix A

ROAD RALLY DRIVER & NAVIGATOR CHAMPIONSHIP

The Championship recognises separately drivers and navigators for awards.

'Closed to club' status road rallies 'Table 1' will attract points to the Road Rally Championship where Rhyl & District Motor Club is listed as an invited club.

The events eligible are any road rally, including classic car rallies at any status where Rhyl & District Motor Club is listed within the event regulations as an invited club.

Points will be awarded as 'Table 2' for National B status or 'Table 3' for National A or International

You must have entered the event under the name of Rhyl & District Motor Club to qualify for points.

All entered will get 5 entry points in addition to any finishing result points as per the tables mentioned above.

TARMAC STAGE DRIVER & CO-DRIVER CHAMPIONSHIP

The Championship recognises separately drivers and co-drivers for awards.

The Championship includes any tarmac stage event of National B status or above where Rhyl & District Motor Club is listed within the event regulations as an invited club.

If the event surfaces are mixed an assessment by the Championship Secretary will be made if the majority is gravel or tarmac.

Points will be awarded as 'Table 2' for National B status or 'Table 3' for National A or International.

You must have entered the event under the name of Rhyl & District Motor Club to qualify for points.

All entered will get 5 entry points in addition to any finishing result points, as per the tables mentioned above.

GRAVEL STAGE DRIVER & CO-DRIVER CHAMPIONSHIP

The Championship recognises separately drivers and co-drivers for awards

The Championship includes any gravel stage events of National B status or above where Rhyl & District Motor Club is listed within the event regulations as an invited club.

If the event surfaces are mixed an assessment by the Championship Secretary will be made if the majority is gravel or tarmac.

Points will be awarded as 'Table 2' for National B status or 'Table 3' for National A or International

You must have entered the event under the name of Rhyl & District Motor Club to qualify for points.

All entered will get 5 entry points in addition to any finishing result points.

Awards will be:-

CLUBMANS CHAMPIONSHIP

As with the existing regulations this Championship does not distinguish between driver and navigator.

The Championship includes Rhyl & District Motor Club own 'Closed to Club' events:-

- Scatters
- Night Navigation Exercises
- 12 Car Rallies
- Treasure Hunts
- Play Station/Games Nights
- Quizzes
- Table Top Rallies

Points will be awarded as 'Table 1' included in these Championship Regulations.

All entered will get 5 entry points in addition to any finishing result points.

Awards will be:-

TOP DOG CLUBMANS DRIVER & NAVIGATOR CHAMPIONSHIP

This Championship recognises both driver and navigator and includes both points awarded in the Top Dog Clubmans Driver

& Navigator Championships for events at 'Clubman' level where Rhyl & District Motor Club has NOT been invited by the Organising Club.

Points will be awarded as 'Table 1' included in these Championship Regulations.

Awards will be:-

1 st Top Dog Clubman Driver	Motor Traders Trophy
1 st Top Dog Clubman Navigator	Regal Trophy

TOP DOG DRIVER & CO-DRIVER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Championship recognises both driver and Co-Driver and includes both points awarded in the National B and higher status Driver & Co-Driver Stage Rally Championships.

Points will be awarded as 'Table 2 & 3' retrospectively included in these Championship Regulations.

Award will be:-

1 st Top Dog Driver	John Harrison Memorial Trophy
1 st Top Dog Navigator	Top Dog Trophy

FRANK WILLIAMS SERIES CHALLENGE CHAMPIONSHIP

This championship consist of a series of Autotests / PCA's at Clubman status and National B status.

To qualify for points a competitor must have entered under the name of Rhyl & District Motor Club.

Points will be awarded in accordance with the status of the event

Awards will be:-

1 st Overall	Frank Williams Memorial Trophy
1 st Novice	An Award

OFF ROAD CHAMPIONSHIP

This championship consists of all Off Road events e.g. Autocross, Rallycross, Car Trial, Autotest, PCA, AutoSolo and Track Events

To qualify for points a competitor must have entered under the name of Rhyl & District Motor Club.

Points will be awarded in accordance with the status of the event. **10 pts will now be awarded to passengers on PCA's and trials.**

Awards will be:-

1 st Overall	Gerry Beasley Trophy
1 st Novice	An Award

MARSHAL & ORGANISING CHAMPIONSHIP

This Championship recognises both marshalling and Rhyl & District Motor Club event organisation.

There are however three exclusions and they are:-

Organising a Night Nav, Treasure Hunt or Scatter the points will be awarded to the Clubmans Championship.

Organising a Social Event points will be awarded to the Social Championship

Points will not be awarded for marshalling on a non-allocated Stage or Test that clashes with a Stage or Test allocated to Rhyl & District Motor Club on that event, unless instructed by the Event Organisers to reassign to a different Stage or Test.

Points will be awarded in accordance with points 'Table 4' within these regulations.

Marshalling on a Rhyl & District Motor Club organised event will attract double points

An Award will be presented to the Marshal of the Year

SOCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP

This championship includes club social events e.g. Quizzes, XBox, Games Nights, Interclub competitions

Points for entering and organising are set out in table 5 within these regulations.

Organisers of main social events i.e Xmas Dinner, Awards Dinner – 30pts

Award will be:-

1st Overall HMS Auto Spares Trophy

LADIES CHAMPIONSHIP

Points scored in any Club Championship by any female Club Member will be transferred to this championship as well.

Awards will be:-

1st Overall Twigdon Cup
2nd Overall Autoquipe Trophy
3rd Overall Highways Cup
1st Novice Ladies Committee Cup

JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

Points scored in any club championship by any member under the age of 21 at the start of the championship year will be transferred to this championship as well.

Award will be:-

1st Overall Dave Evans Memorial Cup

MOST DEDICATED NEWCOMER IN PROMOTING THE CLUB

This will be decided by a panel of three being the Chairperson, Competition Secretary and the President

Les Hewitt Memorial Trophy

MOST DEDICATED CLUBMEMBER

This will be decided by a panel of three being the Chairperson, Competition Secretary and the President.
