Information

1. Trailer Park

Trailers may be left at the trailer park, which is located near scrutineering at Jones Brothers Concrete, Greenfield, Holywell CH8 9DQ (**117 MR 205 767.5**)

Trailers are left entirely at your own risk.

Trailer park will be locked at 20:00 Saturday and re-opened at 04:30 Sunday. If you need trailer parking, please contact the Competition Liaison Officer, Martin Lloyd (tel. mob. 07939 353409), to book your trailer in.

2. Noise & Scrutineering Control

Please see the start venue plan for the location of Noise, Scrutineering and Signing On.

Noise & Scrutineering will take place between 17.00 and 20.00. No individual times are set for visiting Noise Control & Scrutineering. Please arrive early to ensure that you have completed before 20:00. **Noise MR 205 772.5** **Scrutineering MR 212.5 761.5**

Noise Check –

- This will be a 2 Meter noise test with a max 86dba limit.
- Please ensure you collect your Signing On Process Card at Noise Check.
- Once you have left noise, please make sure you have updated your process card with any areas highlighted.

Scrutineering –

- Please ensure you have your vehicle's logbook and M.O.T. certificate for the presentation.
- Please remember your spill kits.
- All tyres, including spares, will be checked at scrutineering for compliance with E-marked tyres.R.18.6.3
- Hydraulic Handbrakes must comply with Construction and Use Regulations. A Hydraulic handbrake is permitted but must incorporate the existing manufacturer's handbrake lever, mounting position and pivot point.

Any vehicle presented for scrutineering that does not comply with the Road Traffic Act, General Regulations section C and Technical Regulations will not be allowed to start and will not be refunded their entry fee.

Motorsport UK-affiliated person will carry out scrutineering and Noise Checks.

3. Signing On

Marshal & Competitor Signing On will be outside the Flint Mountain Park Hotel to the left of the building. (See Start Diagram).

Signing On is open from 17.15 to 20.30

Your Process Card will be issued at Noise Check. You will need it successfully signed at Noise, Scrutineering, and Marshal Signing On before attending Competitor Signing On.

The Majority of Signing on has been done electronically, but if you still need to, please sign on please make sure you have plenty of time to do so.

Competitors must sign on by 20.30 or their place will be offered to a reserve entrant.

- Map Marking Inspection

Maps 116 & 117 - Marking of the Map as per Motorsport U.K. Yearbook and stamping of Map Only highlighting of grid squares and basic start information. You will be asked to remove any other information.

- Club Membership Cards

If you still need an RDMC club membership and wish to apply on the night, payment will be in Cash ONLY.

- Rally Licence Check

You will have to show your RS Clubman Licence or greater status licence

- Insurance

You must sign that you have suitable Road Rally Competition Insurance. We do not need to see the insurance.

Those competitors taking advantage of the Marsh Bluefin Insurance Scheme who have declared they follow the scheme's requirements must have signed and produced their Declaration Form for our retention.

It will save you time at signing if you can download the Form from the RDMC website <https://www.rhyldmc.co.uk/home> and have it completed before signing on.

Those taking advantage of the Marsh Bluefin insurance scheme who do not meet the criteria in the Declaration Form must produce a letter of acceptance showing the Premium to be paid.

- Parental Consent

Competitors Under 18 years MUST have completed a parental consent form. The Form from the RDMC website <https://www.rhyldmc.co.uk/home>

- Outstanding Payments

Any outstanding payments must be Cash Only.

Please help with having exact money for any outstanding payment.

- Rally Packs

Rally Packs will be issued after the successful completion of Signing On

Rally Packs will include: - Rally Plates, Time Cards, PR Sensitive Areas defined by Black Spots / Quiets, N.A.M. Triangles, Allow passage letters, Damage Declaration and any other relevant information relating to the event.

Breakfast tickets will be issued when you return to MC3 In and hand in your BLUE damage declaration form.

Result Query Forms can be obtained if needed from the Secretary of the meeting at results.

4. Drivers Briefing

It will be held at 21.15 near signing on, and all competitors MUST attend this briefing.

5. Route Handout Information

This will be issued at MC 0 by Signing On at 22:00 for car 0 and then at 1-minute intervals according to your start number. A crew member must sign for the handout and produce time card 1 for signature.

Competitors are reminded to keep all route information private from anyone who is not a competitor.

If proven you have divulged route, you may be disqualified at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

6. Marshals

Marshals are essential to running the event, and we ask your marshal to understand where they are going and what they are doing.

Please ensure they have a map, as only a small amount of information is provided to get them to the control. Please ask them also to Download the free what3words app to help them get to their control.

If the marshal who has signed for a competitor does not turn up at their control or leaves the control area before the arrival of the Closing Car or gets reported for driving in a manner likely to bring the sport into disrepute, the associated competitor may be disqualified from the results.

The Chief Marshal / Timekeeper will issue marshals who are allocated time controls with an official clock.

Once finished, the clock must be signed for and handed to the Closing Car or Club Official. Should any clock go missing, the associated competitor will be responsible for replacing or repairing the clock.

- **An A4 Clip Board**
- **A hammer to knock in your Control Board**

8. Controls

All recordings by competitors must be in ink. Code Boards must be signed for at the following manned control (this does not include D.S.O. points or secret checks)

MC Main Time Control.

SS Standard Section Start

SF Standard Section Finish

S.T.C. Standard Time Control

PC Passage Control (should there be insufficient marshals, then the control will be identified with a code board and becomes known as a Route Check).

RC Route Check.

A DSO board will indicate the presence of an official, and competitors are reminded they MUST STOP when requested, or Exclusion may apply.
